



BOUNDARY

Since its founding in the summer of 2017, BOUNDARY has already faced a turbulent first years. The band of five were able to land many celebrated gigs and shows and appeared at the Nova Rock Festival, the Viennese Donauinselfest, and the Dragons Cry Festival at Szene Wien after the release of their first single BETTER OFF DEAD. During this time period their first music video for the single OVERDOSE OF SIN was released.

After a show for an annual MC Wild Eagles' celebration, the musicians joined producer Norbert Leitner in the studio to tape the debut album titled OVERDOSE OF SIN. On January 18, 2019 the released album was presented in its entirety during a live show at the legendary Vienna U4 club. A severe setback for the band followed the successful year 2018. Returning from a concert tour in the Balkan region and planning further steps as a band, singer Goran Pavlovic suffered a stroke. Whereas many other bands might break up due to such a tough situation, they decided to invest it all: They supported Goran in his rehabilitation and amongst other things organized a charity concert for him to cover all incurred costs.

After his successful and complete recovery, the band started working on the second album for which they were able to engage producer Mike Wolff (Kontrust). Moreover, a comeback show was announced for October 2019.
